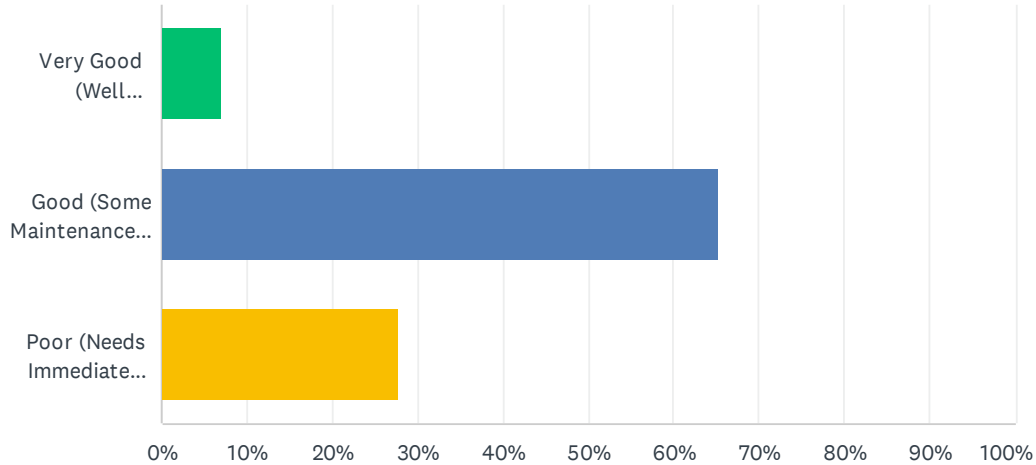

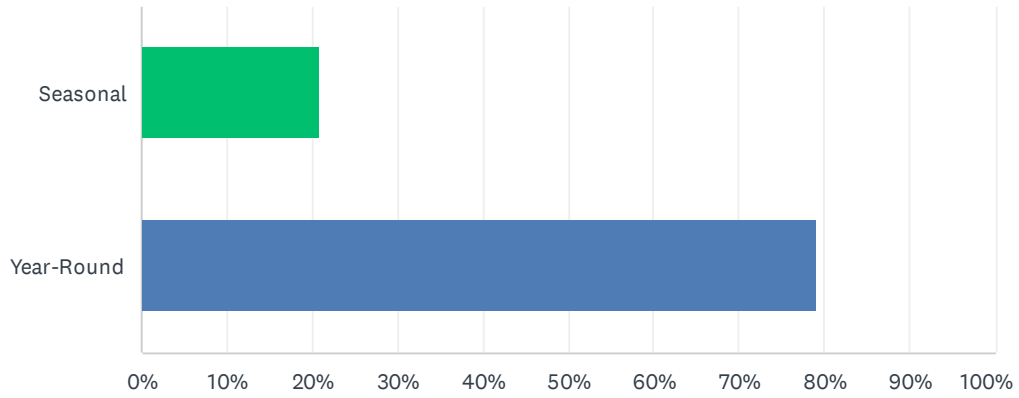

Q23 Are you a seasonal or year-round resident?

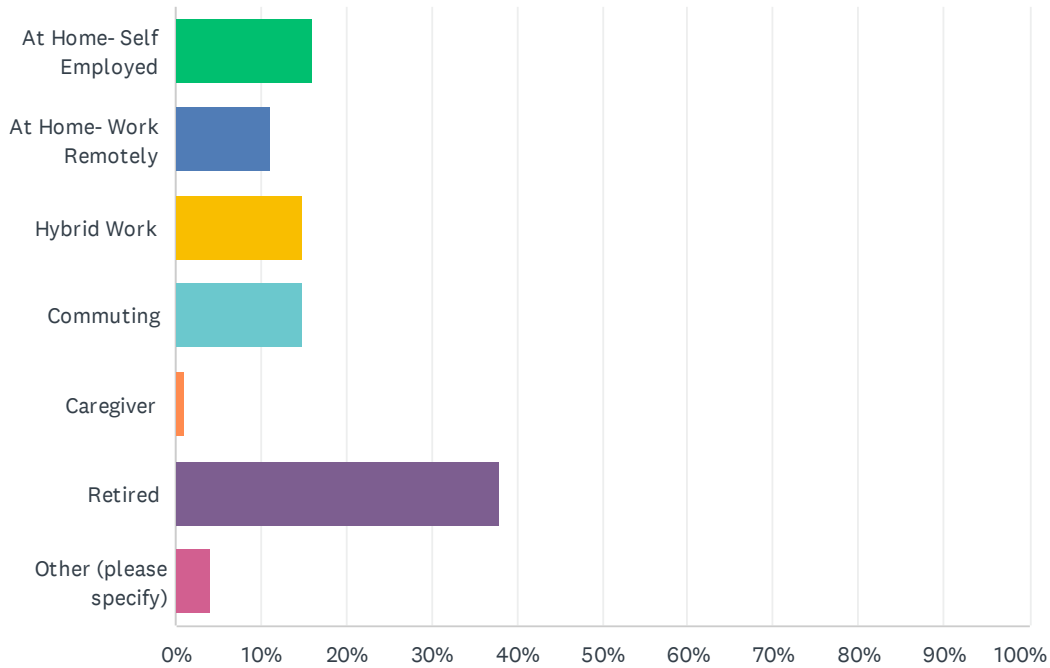

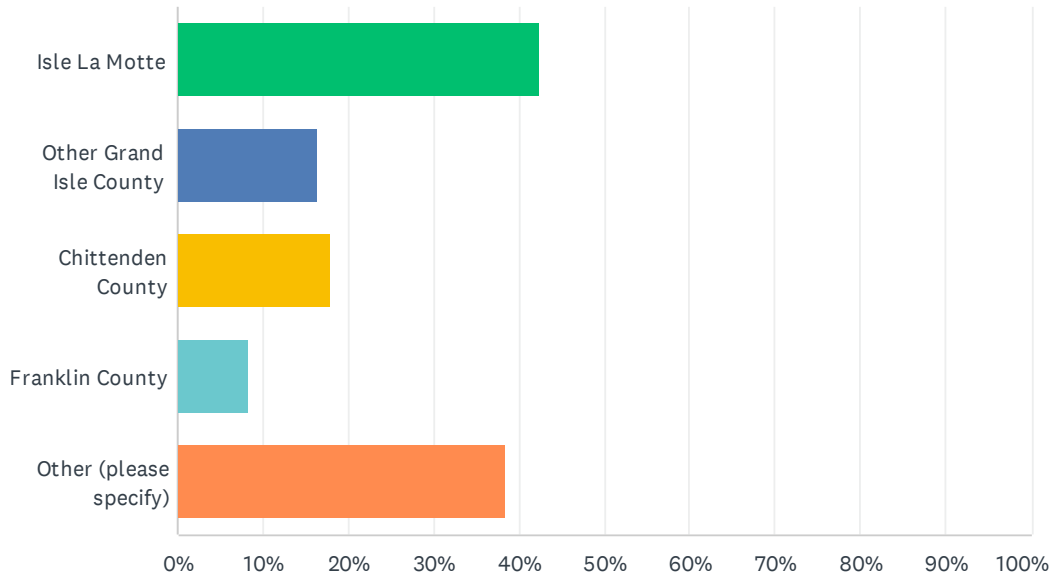

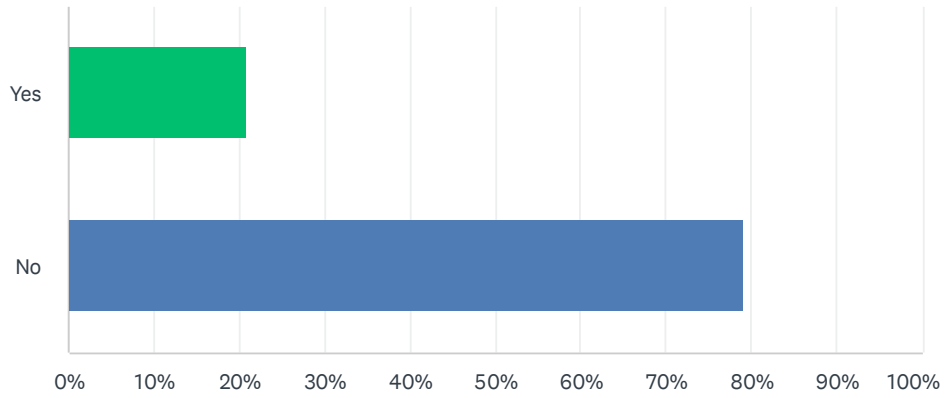

Q26 Do you have school aged children under the age of 18 at your home?

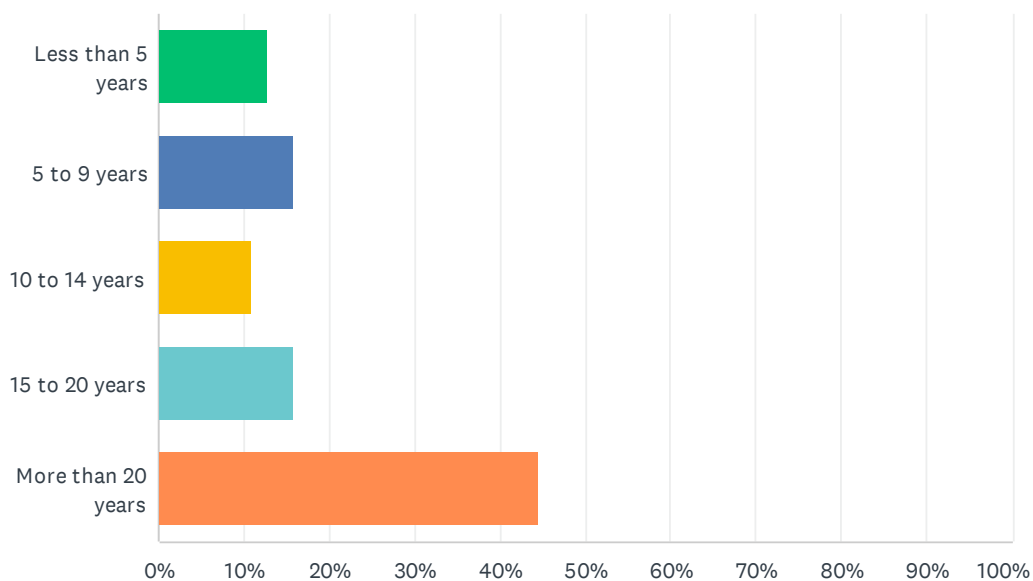
